A BILL

For an ordinance amending Ordinance 705, Series 2007, to rename the “Environmental Seed Capital Fund” and expand the fund’s purpose.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 705 (Series 2007) created the “Environmental Services Seed Capital Program” and “Environmental Services Seed Capital Fund” (fund number 78500) and established the fund’s purpose and allowable income sources; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Health seeks to amend that ordinance to rename the fund and expand the fund’s purpose in order to give the Department of Environmental Health’s Environmental Quality division, which operates the fund, more flexibility with regards to how money in the fund can be spent;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That portion of Sections 1-3 of Ordinance No. 705, Series 2007, amended as follows:

“Section 1. There is hereby established in the Environmental Services Enterprise Fund, Auditor’s No 78000, an “Environmental ~~Services Seed~~ Capital” Program, Accounting No. 78500-6506103-EZ500 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS THAT SUPPORT ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY, MINIMIZE LONG-TERM ENVIRONMENTAL AND FINANCIAL LIABILITY FOR THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER, AND REMEDIATE ENVIRONMENTAL LIABILITIES. ~~The purpose of said Environmental Services Seed Capital program is to support the initial development of worthy environmentally sustainable projects or programs in the City and County of Denver.~~ The program will allocate money to projects that pilot innovative environmental projects, fund innovative projects that have no other funding source, provide matching funds for innovative environmental programs, and provide loans for innovative projects.”

“Section 2. Funding for said Environmental ~~Services Seed~~ Capital Fund shall be annually appropriated from the Environmental Services Enterprise Fund and shall remain available for expenditures in future years.”

1 "Section 3. Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Environmental ~~Services Seed~~ Capital
2 Program" Program, Accounting No. 78500-6506103-EZ500, in the amount not to exceed the total
3 of Deposits described in Section 2 of this Ordinance, as well as any funds remaining from prior
4 appropriations, to be expended by the Manager of Environmental Health."

5 **Section 2.** The Manager of Finance of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized
6 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be
7 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance."
