Location: The proposed Ballpark Denver General Improvement District (GID) boundaries are generally described as a parcel of land lying in Sections 27 and 34, Township 3 South, Range 68 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado. The boundaries are demonstrated in the attached map.

Process: State law requires a public hearing be conducted prior to City Council approving the creation of a general improvement district and that general improvement district's annual work plan and budget. This legislative item is the first of two items related to the formation and establishment of the GID. This resolution will reserve a public hearing date on July 8, 2024. The second legislative item will be an ordinance seeking approval of the Petition, proposed creation ordinance, and 2024 and 2025 work plan and budget.

The ordinance requesting approval of the GID creation and its 2024/2025 work plan and budget will follow this resolution and city staff will be asking for the resolution to pass out of committee on consent since a presentation is anticipated to be conducted as part of the ordinance approving the GID on June 12, 2024 at the Business, Arts, Workforce, Climate and Aviation Services Committee.
