25	Fund No. 12000, which is set forth and described in	Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code

27	Section 3. Expenditures are hereby authorized to	or the "Denver District Attorney State Grants"		
28	Fund, Accounting No. 12307, in the amount not to exceed the amounts awarded as described in
