6 **For an ordinance amending section 14-109 of the Denver Revised Municipal**  
7 **Code concerning the salary and benefits of county court magistrates.**

9 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

10 **Section 1.** That section 14-109, D.R.M.C., is hereby amended by deleting the language  
11 stricken and adding the language underlined to read as follows:

13 **Sec. 14-109 - Salary and benefits of county court magistrates.**

14 (a) Beginning January 1, 2024, eEach full time county court magistrate shall be paid  
15 a salary equal to a compa-ratio of 0.947 of the pay grade applicable to the job classification  
16 entitled "~~Assistant City Attorney—Senior~~" "Assistant City Attorney—Section Supervisor" in  
17 the ~~then~~ current classification and pay plan adopted and maintained in accordance with  
18 chapter 18, division 2 of article II.

19 (b) Beginning January 1, 2024, eEach part time county court magistrate shall be paid  
20 an hourly rate equal to a compa-ratio of 0.947 of the pay grade applicable to the job  
21 classification entitled "~~Assistant City Attorney—Senior~~" "Assistant City Attorney—Section  
22 Supervisor" in the current classification and pay plan adopted and maintained in accordance  
23 with chapter 18, division 2 of article II.
