DCPA has had a lease with the City since 1999 for the 1245 Champa building and parking in the DCPA garage. The lease expires in 2049. DCPA has recently vacated the building and is agreeable to terminating the building portion of the lease but retaining the parking. Additionally, the City entered into a sublease with DCPA in 2005 where Arts and Venues paid to occupy the first floor. This agreement terminates the sublease and gives the City control of the entire building.
