**6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:**

In response to the implementation of Amendment 64, the Budget and Management Office received resource requests from city agencies. The requests have been reviewed, analyzed and prioritized with a goal to address regulation, enforcement and education and focus on the safety of citizens and employees, quality of life for those that live, work, and play in the City and County of Denver and efficient and effective policies and business processes. The prioritized proposals are summarized below. The 22.5 positions are being proposed on a 2.5 year limited basis, whereby the need can be reevaluated based on the business environment.

Additional revenue from the 3.5% Retail Marijuana Special Sales Tax will be used to increase the General Fund Contingency and then the funds will appropriated out of the General Fund Contingency through this supplemental process. An additional \$59,800 will be appropriated in the Environmental Services Enterprise Fund.

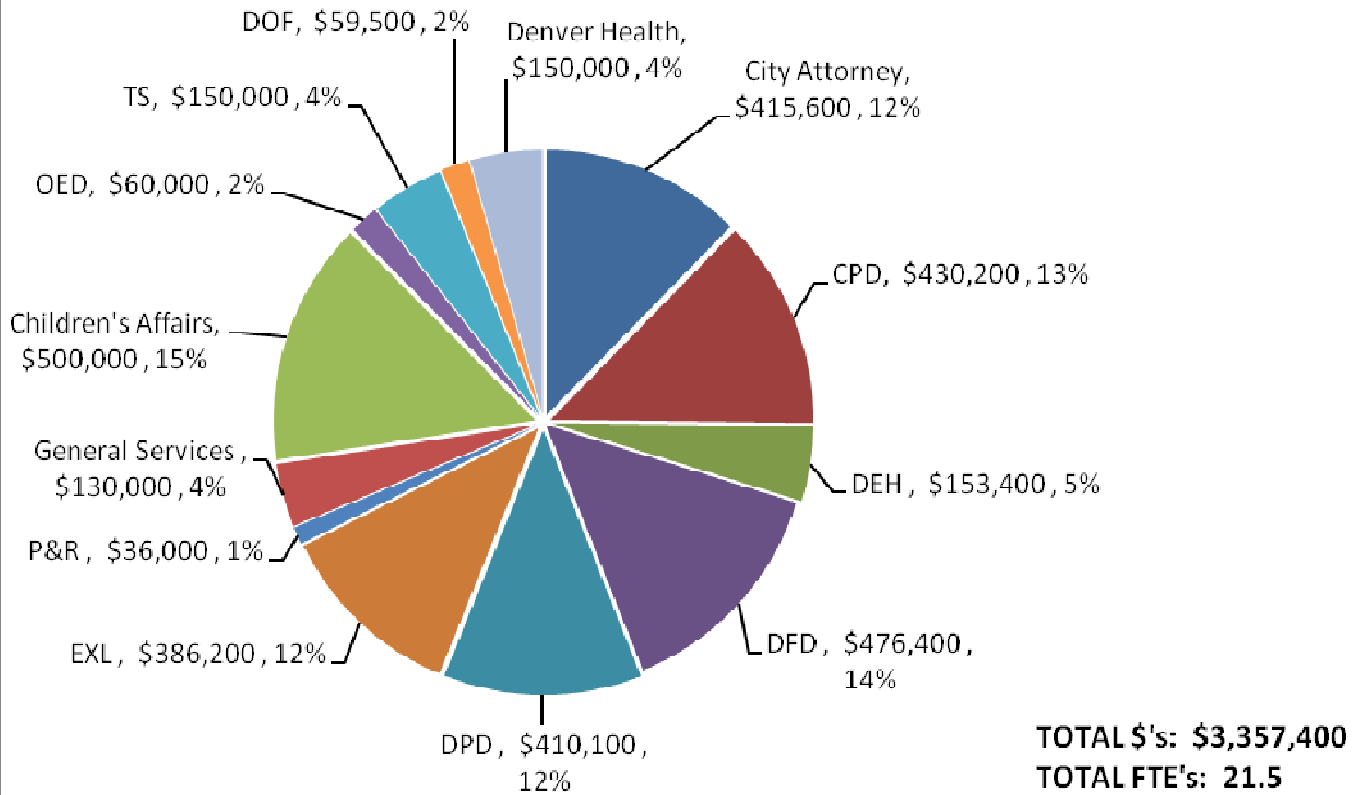
