Attach executive summary if more space needed: Contract for PARCS (Parking Automated Revenue Control System) for Denver Performing Arts Center Garage and other City owned public garages in the future. PARCS manages payment and access to public parking garages operated by DOTI. This is a replacement system for the outdated equipment currently in use. DPAC garage will be installed first, followed by Denver Justice Center Garage, Webb Garage, 303 Garage, Judges Garage and the Denver Cultural Center Garage. Installations will happen one at a time over the course of five years.

The updated equipment will allow DOTI to manage the parking garages more efficiently (operationally and cost), cut back on staffing needs due to enhancements at entrances/exits, ensure we can operate to the fullest ability for large events (DPAC and Cultural Center Garges) that allows us to maximize user experiences. Because of pandemic and reduction in use of garges, this is an ideal opportunity to install equipment and system without disruptions to the resident organizations at the Denver Performing Arts Complex (CO Ballet, CO Symphony, Denver Center for Perfoming Arts, Opera Colorado). This project will also allow DOTI to manage the Webb and other employee parking in Downtown in a more flexible manner that can reflect the changed work force needs post-pandemic.
