BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the action of the Manager of Public Works in vacating the following described alley in the City and County of Denver and State of Colorado, to-wit:

The alley in Block 30, St. Vincent's Addition; be and the same is hereby approved and the described alley is hereby vacated and declared vacated; provided, however, said vacation shall be subject to the following condition and reservation:

There is reserved to the utility owners and to the City and County of Denver the continued use and the right to construct, operate and maintain telephone, power and sewer lines in the vacated alley.
