## ABILL

For an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Division of Criminal Justice concerning the "Federal Crime Victim Compensation FY11" program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF

## DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement, under CFDA No. 16.576, between the State of Colorado and the City and County of Denver, which is identified as Grant No. 11-VC-2, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 11-925, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The Mayor or his lawful successor and other proper officials of the City and County of Denver, in its behalf, are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Grant Agreement and the Clerk and Recorder of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to attest and impress the official seal of the City and County of Denver on the Grant Agreement.

Section 3. The Mayor, his successor in office, or his duly authorized representatives, and other officials of the City are hereby authorized and directed to do all things required to be done in order to obtain payments under the Grant Agreement, including, but not limited to, filing requests for payments, contracting with persons and organizations in order to carry out the provisions of the Grant Agreement, filing reports and keeping records relating to fiscal and evaluation matters, and forwarding other materials to the State of Colorado.

Section 4. The payments made by the State of Colorado to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 12000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 5. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said "Federal Crime Victim Compensation FY11" Program, Accounting No. 12250-0401101-U2066 is as follows, to be expended by the District Attorney:

State of Colorado \$ 1,000,000

Authorization for expenditure of said funds following execution of said grant will cover the period from January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012.

Section 6. The Manager of Finance of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
