A BILL

For an ordinance amending the classification and pay plan for employees in the Career Service and for certain employees not in the Career Service.

WHEREAS, pursuant to 9.1.1 (C) and (D) of the Charter and Article I of Chapter 18, D.R.M.C., the Career Service Authority has recommended to the City Council an amendment to the classification and pay plan governing the compensation of employees in the career service and certain employees not in the career service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That effective **July 24, 2011**, the classification and pay plan is hereby amended by adding the following job titles and associated pay grades, to read as follows:

<u>Job Title</u>	<u>Pay Grade</u>
Executive	824-I
Forensic Laboratory Technician	617-E
Special Education Teaching Assistant	614-O
Special Education Teaching Assistant Supervisor	806-O

Section 2. That effective **July 24, 2011**, the classification and pay plan is hereby amended by changing the pay grade associated with certain job titles to read as follows:

<u>Job Title</u>	<u>Old Pay Grade</u>	<u>New Pay Grade</u>
Deputy City Attorney	821-L	823-L
Deputy Manager of Parks & Recreation	814-A	817-A

Section 3. That effective **July 24, 2011**, the classification and pay plan is hereby amended by changing the job title and pay grade associated with certain job titles, to read as follows:
