A BILL

For an ordinance making an appropriation in the Wastewater Management Enterprise Fund.

WHEREAS, companion ordinance CB22-1163 seeks to amend an intergovernmental agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Urban Drainage Flood Control District (UDFCD) dba Mile High Flood District (MHFD) by adding \$1,150,000 in UDFCD funds, and \$1,150,000 in Wastewater Enterprise funds for final design and construction of drainage and flood control improvements for the Irondale Gulch tributaries; and

WHEREAS, the City will invoice the MHFD \$3,000,000 to construct a portion of the roadway culvert improvements within the City managed 56th Avenue widening project; and

WHEREAS, additional appropriation is required to administer payments to MHFD for the City's portion of the construction;

WHEREAS, to date, \$1,250,000 has been appropriated to support the IGA; therefore, an additional ordinance is required to appropriate the remaining \$3,000,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Wastewater Management Enterprise Fund, Accounting No. 72000, out of monies not otherwise appropriated and in addition to amounts heretofore appropriated by Ordinance No. 1193, Series of 2019, and any supplemental appropriations or rescissions, there is hereby appropriated to the appropriation accounts hereinafter designated the amount of money following such designation, to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:

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2 The foregoing appropriation is to support the City and County of Denver's intergovernmental
 3 agreement with the Urban Drainage Flood Control District for drainage and flood control
 4 improvements along Irondale Gulch.

 7 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary
 8 to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
