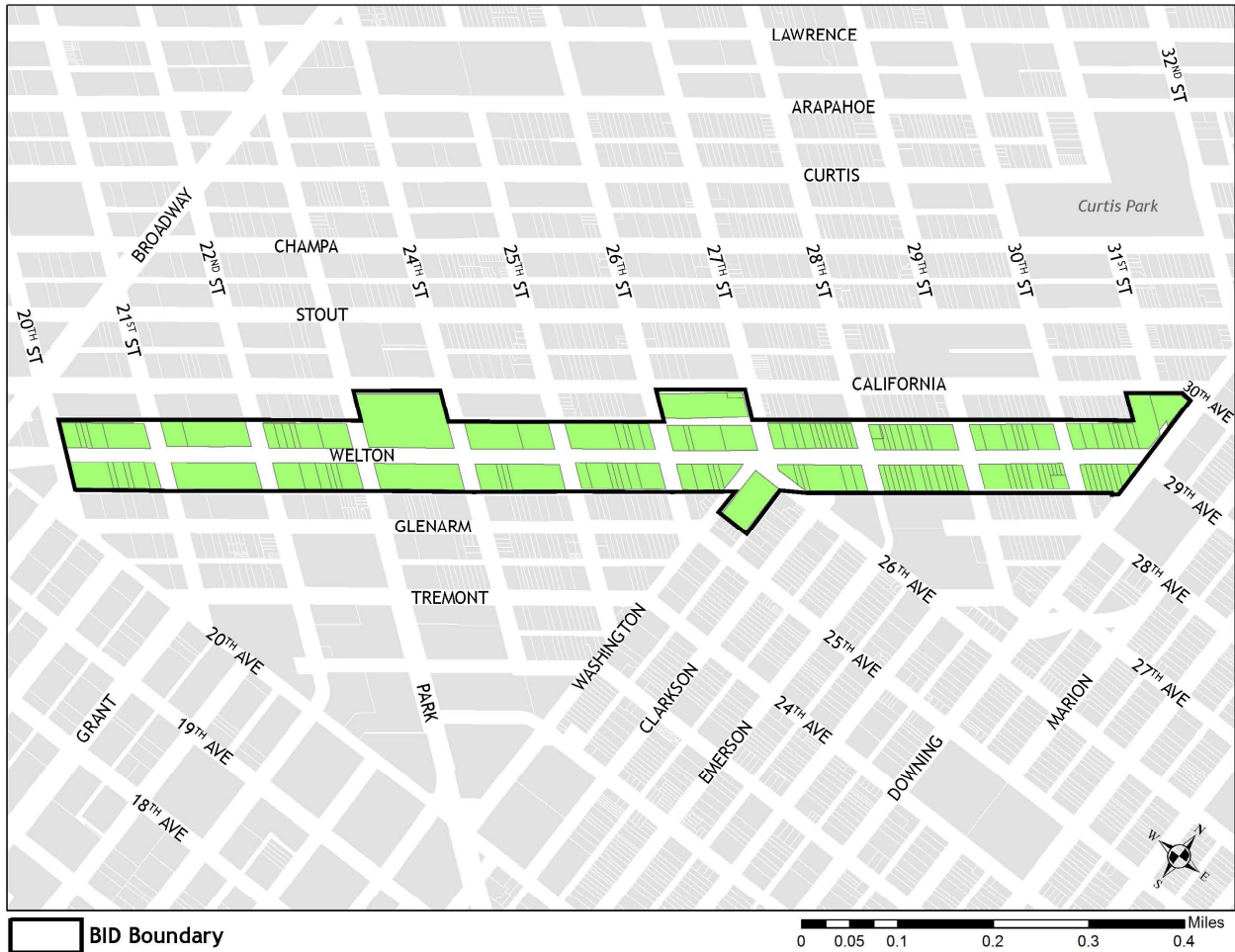
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Five Points Business Association has been working with the Office of Economic Development and Progressive Urban Management Associates to formalize the creation of a Business Improvement District.

City Staff will be asking the Business Development Committee to approve the resolution for the Five Points BID public hearing on consent the week of April 25th. When the creation ordinance moves forward, there will be a presentation on the Five Points BID at the Business Development Committee meeting on May 10th. On May 31st, City Council will hold a public hearing and subsequently vote on the Five Points BID creation ordinance, operating plan and initial budget.
