The Bundle is intended to remove barriers to obtaining zoning approval for property owners and applicants, to improve CPD's review processes, and to improve urban design outcomes by reducing or eliminating complex and counterproductive policies. The Bundle aims to correct and clarify zoning standards while aligning with state law and other City-adopted land use policies. The proposed changes to the Denver Revised Municipal Code are proposed to better comply with state law; to clarify section references in a previous amendment to outdoor gathering areas; and to allow amendments to site development plan and planned building groups under the procedure in the Denver Zoning Code.
