Approves a grant agreement with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for \$1,000,000 and for one year to assist high-risk youth and families through implementation of violence prevention and community youth engagement programs, as well as linkages to trauma-informed behavioral health services, citywide (ENVHL-202159495).

This grant program, called the ReCAST (Resiliency in Communities Affected by Stress and Trauma) grant from the Substance Abuse Mental Health Services Administration features a 5 year grant period requiring DDPHE to renew the agreement every year.

Acceptance of the first year of ReCAST (Resiliency in Communities Affected by Stress and Trauma) grant from the Department of Health and Human Services, SAMHSA (Substance Abuse Mental Health Services Administration). The purpose of the ReCAST Program is to assist high-risk youth and families and promote resilience and equity in communities that have recently faced civil unrest through implementation of evidence-based violence prevention, and community youth engagement programs, as well as linkages to trauma-informed behavioral health services.
