

**Amendment to CB21-0697 concerning align requirements for testing for sexually transmitted infections with state statute.**

**Councilmembers,**

I move that Council Bill 21-0697 be amended in the following particulars:

- 1) On page 1, line 28 strike “knows or has reason to believe,” and replace with “knows,”;
- 2) On page 2, line 3 strike “others;” and replace with “others; or”;
- 3) On page 2, line 4 strike lines 4 through 8;
- 4) On page 2, line 9, strike “(4)” and replace with “(3)”;
- 5) On page 4, line 30 strike “section, and the manager shall may, pursuant to state law,” and replace with “section.”; and
- 6) On page 4, strike line 31. ”

**Purpose of the Amendment**

Explanation: This amendment eliminates departmental discretion of ordering testing of sexually transmitted infections for individuals arrested for prostitution by the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment.

This amendment is non-substantive and does not require republishing.
