[20-0858](#) Approves a surface access license agreement with DCP Wattenberg Pipeline, LLC for \$10,157 and for twenty years for the lease of 525 square feet of land to build a solar powered monitoring device as required by the USDOT for their pipeline on Denver International Airport property (PLANE 202054868).

[20-0891](#) Amends a loan agreement with 48th and Race LLC, managed by the Urban Land Conservancy, by adding five years, allowing for an extension of time for job creation, foregoing immediate repayments in the event of a ground lease, and allowing for a partial release of collateral in the event of a ground lease, for the acquisition of property at 48th and Race for affordable housing in Council District 9.
