**A BILL**

**For an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Transportation concerning the "Peoria Grade Separation, DRCOG Contribution" project and the funding therefor.**

**WHEREAS**, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Intergovernmental Agreement;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** The proposed amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Colorado Department of Transportation and the City and County of Denver, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 12-0235-B, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

**Section 2.** The payments made by the Colorado Department of Transportation to the City pursuant to and under the Intergovernmental Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 38000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

**Section 3.** That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said project is as follows:
