**A BILL**

**For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Wastewater Operations budget.**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure (DOTI) requires the purchase of a new production-level RIZO printer to upgrade DOTI’s mailing capacity; and

**WHEREAS**, said printer will replace the aging equipment and software that currently supports the mailing of storm service bills, compost charges, along with the newly passed volume Based Pricing charges, and other necessary communications with Denver residents; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 1284, Series of 2021, the Annual Appropriation Ordinance, authorized the 2022 spending allocation in Wastewater Operations; and

**WHEREAS**, due to projected savings within the Wastewater Operations Fund budget there are funds available to purchase the printer in 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, said printer is over the \$50,000 threshold for capital equipment items that requires City Council approval, per the Denver Revised Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, this bill request authorizes the purchase of a RIZO printer;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** From the Wastewater Management Enterprise Fund, Accounting No. 72100, the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:
