

# 2016 Denver Health Operating Agreement

Tuesday, October 13, 2015 Safety and Well-being Committee







- The Denver Health and Hospital Authority was formed as a state authority under state statute in 1997 to operate the former Denver General Hospital.
- City/County of Denver adopted a Charter amendment in 1996 to replace the Department of Health and Hospitals with the Department of Environmental Health, which retained the authority and regulatory powers of the local public health agency.
- Annual Operating Agreement outlines services
   Authority provides to the City and City provides to
   Authority.



## Structure of Agreement

- Services are divided into Core Services and Non-Core Services.
- Core services include the Medically Indigent Payment, Emergency Medical Services, Public Health, Denver CARES, prisoner medical services at DHHA, etc.
- Non-Core services include Family Crisis Center, jail medical services at the County Jail, etc.
- City also provides services to DHHA including payroll, legal, radio replacement, fuel, 911 call taker, etc.



## 2016 Operating Agreement

### Highlights of Key Changes

- New programs to support Child Welfare and Medically Indigent.
- Reductions in amounts paid by the City due to Affordable Care Act.
- New Psychology staff for the Jail Inmates
- New At-Risk Intervention and Mentoring (AIM)
  Program to address gang violence

- 911 Call Center Lease Agreement
- OME Relocation and Lease Agreement



## 2016 DHHA Budget Initiatives

Total proposed 2016 contract amount is \$61,156,300 for services to DHHA and receipt of funds in the amount of \$1,838,769 for City services provided for DHHA.
