EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of the ordinance is to approve the service plans for two new metropolitan districts located in RiNo near 38th and Delgany.

The districts will provide public improvements and services for the proposed residential and commercial mixeduse development situated within the River North (RiNo) neighborhood to be known as Hurley Place. The development will include a mix of creative office, restaurant, retail, hotel, entertainment and residential uses in a total of nearly 1,000,000 gross square feet.

The project is being developed by Menalto Development. The project will complement and enhance the existing development within the RiNo neighborhood by creating a new, iconic entertainment and residential hub in the center of the flourishing community.

State law requires notice of a public hearing on the Service Plan which will be at City Council on September 17th. A presentation in Finance and Governance Committee is scheduled on August 28th. Below is a schedule illustrating the City Council process.
