Arts and Venues Special Revenue Fund

• Supplemental appropriation request for \$1,760,000 for the Arts & Venues Special Revenue Fund 15815/3050000 to increase the 2014 expenditure appropriation. This is the operating fund that supports venues such as Red Rocks, Coliseum, McNichols, and Performing Arts Complex venues. The increase is necessary because of increased events over those budgeted and increased support to cultural partners. This increased spending authority will be offset by increased revenue to the SRF in the amount of \$6,100,000, thereby increasing the surplus cash balance and making those funds available for appropriation. This supplemental has no General Fund impact.
