 - a. Scope of Work

Per State house bill #10-1096, County Sheriffs are allowed to certify individuals to perform VIN inspections. In order to provide convenience to citizens to be able to have these inspections done at the Vehicle Impound Facility, the Denver Sheriff Department will start a VIN inspection program. Fees will be charged in order to recoup expenses depending on the type of inspections performed. The three types of VIN Inspections that will be performed are a "Standard" VIN Inspection (\$25 Fee), a "Certified" VIN Inspection (\$45 Fee for the first hour + \$20 for each additional half hour), and an "Unable" VIN Inspection (\$35 Fee). A \$5.00 reproduction fee will be charged for a second copy of VIN Inspection.
