**A RESOLUTION**

**Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Bloomberg Family Foundation, Inc. concerning the “Air Quality Community Action Network (AQ-CAN)” program and the funding therefor.**

**WHEREAS**, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** The proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Bloomberg Family Foundation, Inc., for the “Air Quality Community Action Network (AQ-CAN)” program, which is identified as Grant Number 51628.01, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 201947089-00, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

**Section 2.** The payments made by the Bloomberg Family Foundation, Inc. to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 14000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

**Section 3.** That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment, is as follows:

Expenditures of said funds are authorized from January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2021. The City will provide an in-kind match of up to \$136,500 and a cash match of up to \$242,500.

**Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Resolution.


