This request amends the existing On-Call professional services contract to extend the term of the contract for the full five-year term (ending 6/10/2025) and an increase in overall contract value (totaling \$5,000,000). This will allow for the continuation of remediation, abatement and demolition of environmentally regulated building materials and other properties owned and operated by the City to protect public health, remain in compliance with state laws, and to minimize City environmental liability associated with abatements, renovations, and demolitions. DDPHE-Environmental Quality Division coordinates, through its general abatement contractors, for operation and maintenance activities of regulated building materials and as required abatement actions in conjunction with other City agency's renovation or demolition planning. The use of this general abatement contractor for the full term of 5 years is expected to exceed the current contract value.
