a. Scope of Work

This ordinance will approve a contract for the Arts & Venues Denver Promoter Commission Program to induce the Promoter to host events in City venues. The venues in question are in Council District 8 (DPAC venues) and Council District 9 (Denver Coliseum) and Red Rocks. The contract establishes a commission program to incentivize Promoter to promote and book live concerts and events at the Arts & Venues Denver venues. The purpose of this commission program is to increase revenues to the City in the form of ticket sales and concessions. This program is essentially the same as the program used in calendar year 2012.
