A BILL

For an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) concerning the "Westerly Creek from 33rd Avenue and the Confluence of Sand Creek" project and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Intergovernmental Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the CDPHE and the City and County of Denver, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 15-0197, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the CDPHE to the City pursuant to and under the Intergovernmental Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 38000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said project is as follows:

The foregoing authorization establishes a capital grant fund number and appropriates funds to be received from the CDPHE. Authorization for expenditure of said funds following execution of said Contract will cover the period from May 1, 2105 to November 17, 2019.

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Section 4. The Manager of Finance of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
