- Construction began in 2001 on the largest neighborhood in Denver on the site of the former Stapleton airport.
- Estimated population as of 2020: 25,000 residents
- Public Art Master Plan developed in 2005
- Funding from Denver Urban Renewal Authority (DURA)
- 20 public artworks managed by Barbara Neal on behalf of Park Creek Metropolitan District
