A BILL

For an ordinance amending golf course fees under sub-section 39-121(2) of the Revised Municipal Code.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That subsection 2 (Golf course fees) of section 121 (Schedule for Use of Facilities) of Article IV (Fees and Charges) of Chapter 39 (Parks and Recreation) of the Revised Municipal Code shall be amended by deleting the language and numbers stricken and adding the language and numbers underlined, as follows:

Sec. 39-121. (2) Golf course fees:

a. *Annual fees:*

- Unlimited play for Denver residents only (not good on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays or holidays) includes reservation card \$550.00
- Plus, per round, 9 holes 4.00
- Plus, per round, 18 holes 6.00

~~Effective July 21, 2008, no Annual Cards will be issued except to Annual Card holders who purchased an Annual Card the preceding year.~~

b. *Course fees:*

1. At City Park, Willis Case, Overland, Kennedy, and Wellshire Golf Courses, the following fees shall apply:
