5 **A BILL**

6 **For an Ordinance approving a proposed donation of the fallen officer memorial**  
7 **from the City and County of Denver to the Denver Police Law Enforcement**  
8 **Museum, Inc., d/b/a, the Denver Police Museum.**

9 **WHEREAS**, the granite fallen officer memorial was commissioned by the Police Athletic  
10 League (“PAL”) in conjunction with the development of the PAL building located at 1240 Bayaud  
11 Avenue, Denver, Colorado in 2006; and

12 **WHEREAS**, funds to construct the memorial came from money that the late Bill Daniels left  
13 for the Police Athletic League in his final arrangements; and

14 **WHEREAS**, in October of 2020 PAL sold the property at 1240 Bayaud to the City of Denver;  
15 and

16 **WHEREAS**, in the contract under Recitals of the sale agreement, PAL was to maintain  
17 ownership of the gym equipment, some refrigerators and the granite memorial. The sales  
18 agreement also stipulated that all property not removed from the facility by the closing date will be  
19 conveyed to the city, and

20 **WHEREAS**, due to the COVID pandemic, the granite memorial was not removed by PAL  
21 prior to the closing and was therefore conveyed to the city; and

22 **WHEREAS**, because the memorial is important to honoring, remembering, and preserving  
23 the history of Denver Law Enforcement, the Denver Police Museum, a nonprofit organization, would  
24 like to acquire the memorial; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the proposed donation cannot be made until approved by the Council of the City  
26 in accordance with subsection 2.9.3 (c), Part 9, of Article II of the Charter of the City.

27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**  
28 **DENVER:**

29 **Section 1.** The proposed donation of fallen officer memorial to the Denver Police Museum
