BR13-0321 Adds \$1,125,000 and five years to the contract with West Publishing Corp (CE85004-02) for electronic legal research for the City Attorney's Office.

C. Denver International Airport - Amy Raaz

BR13-0322 Accepts a grant from the Colorado Department of Transportation, Division of Aeronautics for rehabilitation of Pena Boulevard to occur in 2013-2015, and to cover the costs of its use by non-airport drivers per compliance with FAA requirements (PLANE 201310740-00).

D. <u>Department of Safety - Jeannie Springer</u>

BR13-0323 Approves a fifth amendment to the Xerox State and Local Solutions contract to extend the term of the agreement by 18 months through December 31, 2014 and to add \$2,051,550 for continued services related to the Photo Radar Speed Enforcement System (CE-81107-05).
