**For an Ordinance designating the projects to be undertaken and funded with the proceeds of any general obligations bonds authorized by voters at the November 2, 2021 election.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** The Mayor and Council designate the following projects and level of funding to be undertaken with the proceeds of any general obligations bonds authorized by voters at the November 2, 2021 election.

Purpose 1. For the funding of Denver facilities system.

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9 **Section 2.** If any project listed in Section 1 of this Ordinance is held to be invalid by a court of  
10 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the other parts and provisions of any general  
11 obligations bonds authorized by voters at the November 2, 2021 election and this Ordinance.

12 **Section 3.** Within each purpose, any modifications to add or remove a line item project will  
13 require an amendment of this Ordinance by the Denver City Council. Whenever a line item project set  
14 forth in this Ordinance includes a list of specific locations where the project will be undertaken, any  
15 modification to remove any listed location will require an amendment to this Ordinance by the Denver  
16 City Council.

1           **Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer, as the Manager of Finance/*Ex-Officio* Treasurer shall  
2 describe progress of the expenditure of the funds for each purpose listed above in a report to a  
3 committee of the Denver City Council at least annually.

4           **Section 5.** This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage by the electorate of the November  
5 2, 2021 ballot question(s) that authorize the any general obligation bonds for the purposes referenced  
6 herein.
