10	WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 556, Series of 2006, established the Denver Preschool Program		
11	for the governance and administration of the dedicated sales and use tax increases and for the		
12	purpose increasing access to and quality of preschool programs for Denver residents, as approved		
13	by Denver voters in the 2006 election; and		
14	WHEREAS, the Denver Preschool Program Fund, Fund number 11851 was created		
15	through Ordinance No. 309, Series of 2007, for the purpose of receiving and accounting for the		
16	Denver Preschool Program's portion of sales and use tax receipts as approved by Denver voters in		
17	the 2006 election; and		
18	WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 309, Series of 2007, established an unappropriated fund		
19	balance to mitigate against potential financial risk should actual revenue fall short of projected		
20	revenue, and		
21	WHEREAS, the City has held the balance in the Denver Preschool Program Special		
22	Revenue Fund for the past 15 years; and		
23	WHEREAS, since the program started, the Denver Preschool Program has accumulated		
24	significant reserves and does not require the unappropriated fund balance to sustain programming		
25	in the event of a revenue shortfall; and		
26	WHEREAS, the Denver Preschool Program and the Office of Children's Affairs desires to		
27	amend Ordinance No. 309, Series of 2007, to remove the fund balance requirement for the Denver		
28	Preschool Program for the purpose of allowing the Denver Preschool Program to spend those dollars		
29	on programs;

2	"The City will maintain an unappropriated restricted fund balance in the special revenue fund in			
3	order to minimize the effects of significant fluctuations in the amount of sales and use tax			
4	revenues received for any calendar year. The unappropriated fund balance for calendar year			
5	2007 is estimated to be \$600,000."

7	Section 2. The prior Section 7 of Ordinance No. 309, Series of 2007, is hereby amended to be			
8	a renumbered Section 6, and to read as follows:			
9	Section 76. The Auditor and Treasurer Chief Financial Officer of the City and			
10	County of Denver are is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record			
11	entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes			
12	of this Ordinance.
