Alexis Rain is a born and raised urban indian of Denver, local community organizer, poet and full time traditional knowledge keeper. Both Chicana and Western Shoshone she is deeply rooted in the city that raised her. She is motivated to be a helping force; and has always centered herself in community care and movement building. From grants to budgeting, her efforts to increase food security is at the forefront of everything she has done. She is critically aware of the pitfalls her neighbors experience so in her position as a Denver Public Library worker she bridged language and digital gaps for patrons, and built pathways for community building within her community center.

As a Denver Public School/ NACE (Native American Culture and Education) alumni she has stepped into her current position with reverence. She is carving a path for her students rooted in cultural and spiritual care, efforts that she wished for as a student. Alexis has brought in many community connections within her classroom so that once students leave it they may still call upon the community connections made.
