Xcel Energy owns, operates and maintains City Street Lights. The City pays for all maintenance and energy charges. The field survey will result in a comprehensive street light inventory that will provide many attributes of the lights, as well as a GIS location for the asset so that GIS layer can be created for analytical and reconciliation purposes. This will encompass approximately 50,000 street lights and 5,000 Parks and trail lights. This inventory will be analyzed and used to aid in the conversion of High Pressure Sodium lights to Light Emitting Diodes (LED's).
