The Green Workforce Hub Collaborative will collectively work together to achieve the goals of the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG), Green Workforce Hub program. Each participating workforce center that is part of the Green Workforce Hub Collaborative will:

- Hire a Green Career Navigator
- Create localized career pathways into the decarbonization trades that includes training providers and employers. The decarbonization trades are:
 - Construction and Building Inspectors (SOC 47-4011)
 - Miscellaneous Construction and Related Workers (Weatherization) (SOC 47-4098)
 - Heating, Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration Mechanics and Installers (SOC 49-9021)
 - Sheet Metal Workers (SOC 47-2211)
 - Plumbers, Pipefitters, and Steamfitters (SOC 47-2152)
 - Electricians (SOC 47-2111)
 - Electrical and Electronics Repairers, Commercial and Industrial Equipment (SOC 49-2094)
- Justification for training providers and associated training cost
- Completed 10 outreach and recruiting activities per year
- Complete two training session about the Green Workforce Hub program to all customer-facing staff at their workforce center
- Enroll eligible participants into the program and provide case management services.

- o Providing a Needs Assessment to all enrolled participants
- o Creating an Individualized Employment Plan with all enrolled participants
- o Providing wrap-around services to all enrolled participants

- Complete required data entry for each participant into the selected CRM software, Connecting Colorado
- Run monthly reports on grant progress and provide that to Arapahoe/Douglas Works!
- On a quarterly basis, provide information to Arapahoe/Douglas Works! regarding grant outcomes
- Engage in required grant meetings, including Bi-Weekly Check-Ins and Quarterly Meetings with DRCOG staff

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
