**A BILL**

**For an ordinance making a rescission and a supplemental appropriation from the General Fund Contingency to Human Rights and Community Partnerships.**

**WHEREAS**, the Human Rights and Community Partnerships requires \$150,000 in additional resources in 2019 to support the City’s contract with the Denver Immigrant Legal Service Fund of the Denver Foundation to provide direct legal representation to immigrants;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** From appropriations heretofore made from the General Fund listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded" and transferred to the General Fund:
