Colorado's Unaccompanied Refugee Minor (URM) Program places overseas children with refugee status and children in the custody of the Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR) living in the United States into the care and custody of City and County of Denver Human Services (DHS). Colorado Refugee Services Program (CRSP), located in the Office of Economic Security, Colorado Department of Labor and Employment (CDLE), administers programming and funds for the URM Program.

However, if there are "problems or complaints concerning the care or treatment of a child" based on Denver Human Services (DHS) assessment of LFSRM placements, DHS has the right and responsibility to make foster placement decisions in the best interest of the child (7.304.661(c)).
- 3. DHS agrees to participate in URM monthly meetings, annual URM trainings, and other reasonable requests for the purpose of maintaining current on rules and practices related specifically to serving URM eligible populations and to maintain collaborative working relationships with LFSRM.
