16	approving them by resolution and reduce the time it takes to complete a contract with the

19	the residents, businesses and nonprofit entities who contract with the city by reducing the			
20	contracting time.

23	Section 1. That Section 13-11.5, "Resolutions", of the Revised Municipal Code is hereby

26	(a) Action by resolution allowed. The council shall act by bill and ordinance on any matter			
27	requiring the approval of the council, except as otherwise provided by this section. In lieu of a bill			
28	and ordinance, council may act by resolution upon the following matters:			
29	(1) An appointment or confirmation of an appointment to any board or commission or			
30	to any other office or position of employment for which council is the appointing authority,			
31	and the removal of any such appointee or employee;			
32	(2) The adoption or amendment of any council rule of procedure pursuant to section			

(3) Approval of any action required by state or federal law, when approval by

resolution is permitted by the applicable state or federal law.
