Finance & Services

- BR15- 0159 Revises two sections (53-27(a) and 53-98(a)) of the Denver Revised Municipal Code to reflect the new standard tax rate of 3.65% approved by the voters to support the Denver Preschool Program.
- BR15- 0173 Amends an Exchange Agreement (North Fire Station Swap – Filing 13/44 Stapleton) with Forest City II, LLC to adjust escrow terms and stagger closing dates (FINAN-201416696-01).

Infrastructure & Culture

- BR15- 0153 Approves a \$715,221 purchase order with Daniels Long Auto to purchase 13 Chevrolet Cruz, 12 Chevrolet Malibu, 11 Chevrolet Equinox, 1 Chevrolet Equinox AWd, and 1 Chevrolet Equinox Report Writer for the Police Department (PWOPS 000011992).
- BR15- 0165 Approves the partial alley vacation at 3300 East 1st Avenue in Council District 10.
- RR15- 0163 Dedicates land as public right-of-way for an alley in the block bounded by Detroit Street, Fillmore Street, 2nd Avenue, and 3rd Avenue in Council District 10.
- BR15- 0152 Removes the requirement for TR Park Central's contract to carry Workers Compensation Insurance as approved by the Risk Management Office since the contractor does not employ anyone at the Skyline Park patio seating area in Council District 8 (RC72014).
- RR15- 0171 Grants a revocable permit to TCNC, LLC to encroach into the right-of-way with raised concrete and wood patios, a seasonal fabric enclosure, entry vestibule, and valet shed at 1700 Humboldt Street in Council District 8.

BR15- Approves a master purchase order with Graybar Electrical for \$3 million
0155 to provide electrical and data network supplies for a number of technology projects (MPO 5761U0115).

RR15- Approves the Mayoral appointments of Barry Burch, Jr., Katherine
0156 Burse, Brandé Micheau, Shayla Sanders, and Victoria Wisdom to the Denver African American Commission for terms effective immediately and expiring on 05-01-16, or until successors are duly appointed.

Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion.
