Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Parks and Recreation Admission 24 Based Events" Fund, Accounting No. 15826-7011000, in the amount not to exceed the total of 25 deposits described in Section 2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the Manager of Parks and
