Scope of work:

Re:Vision is a nonprofit that uses food as an entree into community self-sufficiency via their urban agriculture model, hiring and training community members to lead our food-based programs, youth education opportunities, and nurturing small businesses. Through their HFDC grant, they are sustaining their family garden program and curriculum that serves 250 families, growing 2 summer cohorts of their Semillas de Esperanza youth nutrition and food sovereignty curriculum to expand from 6 to 8 weeks, 1 summer and 1 fall cohort of their Xulinaria nutrition and culinary food skills curriculum to expand from 6 to 8 weeks, and maintaining their 24-week Semillas de Agua youth hydroponic apprenticeship at Re:Vison. Additionally, they are also expanding, adapting to a school setting, and launching their Semillas de Esperanza and Semillas de Agua curriculums in partnership with Emerald Gardens to students of both DSISD and North High School to deliver our collaboratively adapted curriculums to 50 DSISD youth and 50 North High School youth in the 2023/24 school year and in subsequent years.
