5. General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed –

The Denver Fire Department (DFD) is seeking authorization for a capital equipment purchase to replace a vehicle that was hit by another vehicle and totaled while in service (Claim #25-1216). This vehicle is a first responder unit and will cover all of Fire District 6 responses and help cover Fire Districts 2, 3, and 7 on big fire events. As of right now, Fire District 6 is using one of the reserve vehicles to cover the responsibilities, which leaves DFD with one less reserve vehicle for other District vehicles and Med Units. This replacement vehicle is critical as it is a front-line vehicle and needs to be in service as soon as possible.

This purchase will be authorized out of the Risk Management Special Revenue Fund (11838). The cost of a new vehicle exceeds the \$50,000 threshold that requires authorization for purchase. The total estimated cost for the replacement is \$72,245.00, subject to estimates. This will include the upfits of lights & sirens.
