This request is for an amendment between Marsh, USA (Marsh), and Denver International Airport (DEN) to provide additional funding for DEN's ROCIP4 program. This program provides insurance, safety, loss control, and administrative support for DEN's major construction projects. DEN's broker (Marsh) not only provides professional services but also the insurance premiums and Loss Fund amounts are paid through our broker. This funding will address additional premium and fees for the program's growth. The program currently is bound with \$2,044,763,784 in construction value. After reviewing DEN's 10-year CIP, an additional \$368,693,048 in construction value is required to cover DEN's large construction projects. The increase in funding includes insurance premiums, broker fees, and providing capital for the Loss Fund. The additional projects added to the ROCIP4 program were not foreseen at the previous amendment.

DEN's ROCIP programs are integral to all pillars of Vision 100, particularly "Growing Our Infrastructure" and "Maintaining What We Have." ROCIP4 encompasses critical projects such as Pena Blvd Phase 1B, Great Hall Completion Phase, and the Annual Pavement Rehabilitation initiatives, among others. These projects not only enhance our infrastructure to accommodate increasing passenger volumes but also ensures the longevity and reliability of our existing assets.
