- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved
  - a. Scope of Work

The City seeks professional design engineering and related consulting services for the Reconstruction of Federal Boulevard from 5th Avenue to Howard Place in accordance with the Proposed Action as stated in the Planning Environmental Linkage Study (PEL) completed in October of 2009 for this stretch of Federal Boulevard. Three southbound lanes and three northbound lanes will be constructed, as well as a raised center median. Services are described in the RFP and will include public involvement, stakeholder and agency coordination, engineering and related design (traffic, traffic control, roadway, civil, geotechnical, landscaping, pavement, drainage, erosion control, hydrology and hydraulic, water quality, lighting, and construction phasing), utility coordination, surveying, right-of-way, and environmental services.
