ORDINANCE NO. 3 SERIES OF 2010 **COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE:** 4 FINANCE 5 6 7 A BILL 8 9 For an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States of 10 America concerning the "Emergency Shelter FY2010" program and the funding 11 12 therefor. 13 14 15 WHEREAS, by authority of Ordinance No. 732, Series of 2009, the City was authorized to 16 enter into a grant agreement with the United States of America, Department of Housing and 17 Urban Development, for an "Emergency Shelter FY2010" program based on a Letter of Intent; 18 and 19 WHEREAS, the United States has tendered to the City the final grant award; and 20 WHEREAS, the pursuant to Denver Revised Municipal Code (DRMC) Section 20-52, 21 inasmuch as the Emergency Shelter Grant for fiscal year 2009, in combination with the 22 Emergency Shelter Grant for fiscal year 2010, will exceed \$500,000; and 23 WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed 24 Grant Agreement; 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER: 26 27 Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement, under CFDA No. 14.231, between the United 28 States of America and the City and County of Denver, which is identified as Grant Number S-10-29 MC-08-0003, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 09-1154-A, be and 30 hereby is approved in all respects. 31 Section 2. The Mayor or his lawful successor and other proper officials of the City and 32 County of Denver, in its behalf, are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Grant 33 Agreement and the Clerk and Recorder of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized 34 and directed to attest and impress the official seal of the City and County of Denver on the Grant 35 Agreement. 36 Section 3. The Mayor, his successor in office, or his duly authorized representatives, and 37 other officials of the City are hereby authorized and directed to do all things required to be done 38 in order to obtain payments under the Grant Agreement, including, but not limited to, filing

requests for payments, contracting with persons and organizations in order to carry out the provisions of the Grant Agreement, filing reports and keeping records relating to fiscal and evaluation matters, and forwarding other materials to the United States of America.

Section 4. The payments made by the United States of America to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 13000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 5. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said "Emergency Shelter FY2010" Program, Accounting No. 13009-5511101-H1118 is as follows, to be expended by the Manager of Human Services:

11 Authorized by prior ordinance \$202,040

12 Authorized by this ordinance 190,587

13 Federal Government \$392,627

Authorization for expenditure of said funds following execution of said grant will cover the period from January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010.

Section 6. The Manager of Finance of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
