Amendment to Council Bill 23-1960 concerning the removal of shelter when the outside temperature is predicted to be thirty-two degrees Fahrenheit or lower

Councilmembers,

I move to amend CB23-1960 as follows:

1. On page 2, strike line 1 and replace with:

"period when the removal will occur or within two (2) hours after anticipated completion of the removal."

- 2. On page 2, strike line 11 and replace with the following: <u>"(1) The external ambient"</u>
- 3. On page 3, strike line 12 and replace with:

"period when the removal will occur or within two (2) hours after anticipated completion of the removal."

PURPOSE OF THE AMENDMENT

This amendment allows officers enforcing the unauthorized camping prohibition to assess the temperature in real time instead of 48 hours in advance. The amendment also reduces the amount of time where the national weather service prediction is operative for the purposes of DDPHE and DOTI enforcement. The operative period of time is reduced from four hours after the anticipated completion of removal to two hours.
