A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Climate Protection Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, the Denver Police Department (DPD) is seeking approval for a capital equipment purchase of two electric vehicles to support an interagency agreement between the Office of Climate Action, Sustainability, and Resiliency (CASR) and the DPD for a pilot project that will allow DPD to test using EV technology; and

WHEREAS, said purchase will be authorized from CASR’s “Climate Protection Special Revenue Fund” (11880); and

WHEREAS, said vehicles are over the \$50,000 threshold for capital equipment items that require City Council approval, per the Denver Revised Municipal Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Climate Protection Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11880, the Executive Director of the Office of Climate Action, Sustainability, and Resiliency, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

Section 2. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
