A BILL

For an ordinance to approve annual programs of the Department of Public Works and waive the need for further City Council approval for specific contracts let pursuant to the annual program.

WHEREAS, under Charter §3.2.6, the City Council has the authority to approve contracts of \$500,000 or more; and

WHEREAS, under Charter §3.2.6(H), the City Council has the authority to waive the requirement that such contracts be submitted to the council for approval or disapproval under Charter §3.2.6, and

WHEREAS, City Council has reviewed the annual program for the Department of Public Works which consists of:

17 **Section 1.** Pursuant to Charter §3.2.6(H), the City Council hereby approves the letting of
18 contracts to implement the annual program of the Department of Public Works, as set forth below,
19 and waives the requirement that contracts, as defined in Charter §3.2.6(A), let to implement this
20 annual program be submitted to City Council for approval or disapproval under Charter §3.2.6.

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9 **Section 2. Monthly Reports.** The Department of Public Works shall provide monthly written
10 reports to City Council listing all contracts let under its annual program, including the name of the
11 contractor, the amount of the contract, the term of the contract, the M/WBE goals established for
12 each contract and which contracts are included in the SBE set aside program. The Department of
13 Public Works shall meet with City Council to discuss the annual programs quarterly or as
14 requested by City Council.
