EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of the ordinance is to approve the assignment of \$7.5 million of Denver's Private Activity Bond allocation to Denver Housing Authority (DHA).

The allocation will be used for the final phase of the redevelopment of rental housing at the HOPE VI Mariposa redevelopment site. The final phase will create 45 affordable senior/disabled housing units: 14 units at or below 30% AMI and 31 units at or below 60% AMI. The unit mix is as follows:

One Bedroom	38 Units
Two Bedroom	7 Units

DHA will be the direct issuer of bonds in this transaction which is currently scheduled for a closing in the fourth quarter of 2015. The construction effort will be approximately 14-16 months with unit delivery anticipated in early 2017.
