A. Boards and Commissions - Anthony Aragon

RR12-0247 Approves the Mayoral appointment of Bridget Kaminetsky to the Welfare Reform Board for a term effective immediately and expiring January 1, 2014 or until a successor is duly appointed.

B. Career Service Authority - Anthony Aragon/Bruce Backer

RR12-0246 Approves the Mayoral appointment of Derrick Fuller to the Career Service Authority Board of Directors for a term effective immediately and expiring on September 16, 2014 or until a successor is duly appointed.

BR12-0220 Abolishes Career Service Authority jobs of 911 Lead Operator, 911 Operator, Aviation Tour Guide, Epidemiological Research Technician, Health Information Supervisor, Nuclear Medicine Technologist Supervisor, Nurse Midwife, Physician Assistant, Public Health Dentist and Senior Plus Case Coordinator; revises Community Rate Schedule A per state law and changes corresponding pay grades of Activities Leader I – Non Certified, Activities Leader II – Certified, Advanced Lifeguard, Fitness Instructor I – Non Certified, Fitness Instructor II – Certified, Lifeguard, Pool Supervisor, Sports Official I- Non Certified, Sports Official II – Certified and adds pay grade and job code of Television & Video Production Support Technician.

C. Community Planning and Development - Theresa Lucero

BR12-0249 Rezones from U-SU-C1 (urban context, residential single-unit) to U-MX-2x (urban context, mixed use, low intensity) property containing a commercial structure at 4100 Federal in Council District 1.

D. Parks and Recreation - Fred Weiss

BR12-0248 Approves a lease with The Greenway Foundation for use the City building in Habitat Park for \$1 per year plus other maintenance considerations for programming, meeting and office space for a term ending 12-31-17, in Council District 7.

E. Public Works - Stacie Loucks

BR12-0243 Vacates a two-foot wide strip of the west side of Central Street between Kensing Court and 17th Street for new development in Council District 9.

BR12-0251 Amends the Intergovernmental Agreement with Denver Public Schools regarding City collection of trash, recycling and compost to extend the term 3 years and to allow the City to offer compost to certain sites.

BR12-0252 Approves a no-cost extention to 12-31-13 to the contract with Tsvouras, Simmons & Holderness for design of the Federal Blvd. Reconstruction project from 5th Ave. to Howard Pl. in Council Districts 1, 3 and 9 (CE02011).

BR12-0253 Approves \$899,022 Master Purchase Order with MacDonald Equipment Co. for 3 asphalt pothole patch trucks.(PWOPS0000005855)

BR12-0254 Approves a \$1,218,028 Master Purchase Order with Pierce Manufacturing Inc. for velocity ladder and velocity pumper for the new Lowry Fire Station in Council District 5. (PWTRN0000003493).

RR12-0255 Dedicates a tract as public right-of-way for widened sidewalk at 3151 and 3145 W. Florida in Council District 3.

RR12-0257 Dedicates a parcel of land as public right-of-way at the intersection of Mile High Stadium West Circle and Morrison Rd. as part of the West Corridor FasTracks project in Council District 9.

F. Safety - Jeannie Springer

BR12-0256 Amends a contract with Enterprise Leasing Company of Denver (dba Enterprise Fleet Management) to extend the term of the lease agreement for 24 months through June 30, 2014 and to add \$300,626, to provide leased vehicles to the Denver Police Department for undercover surveillance operations.
